What do I need for the Workshop?

Coniferous Tree Making Workshop By Tony Czerneda

The goal of this hands on work shop will be the making of 6 to 12 trees that will be ready to plant on your layout. Trees will be made from florist wire and sisal. We will use Woodland Scenics ground foam to add the green foliage using a 50-50 glue/water mix. I expect the work sessions to last about 2 hours.

Equipment you will need to bring with you:

- Scissors
- One or two containers of coarse ground foam (different colours of green)
- Needle nose pliers
- Sharp knife to cut the sisal and a board to protect the table when you are cutting
- Clamp to secure a 1 inch board to the table
- Small spring clamp to secure wire while you are spreading the sisal
- Pencil or ¼ wooden dowel (about 6 inches long) to spin the wire or an electric screw driver with a small Allen wrench or hex key
- Wire cutters
- Newspaper or plastic drop sheet to protect the table/floor etc.
- If you have some Woodland Scenics foam, bring it along

Equipment Supplied or borrowed:

- Florist wire
- Sisal
- Aluminum pans to keep your work contained and you can take your trees home in the pans.
- Styrofoam
- White Glue
- Jig for setting up the wire and sisal with measurements in HO feet (some with N gauge feet)
- Some plastic drop sheets and newspaper
